**Resolution 2021-03: Establishment of Salaries and Hourly Wages / Ranges for Full and Part Time Positions for Fiscal Year 2021.**

WHEREAS, the Fire District deems it necessary to establish salary and hourly wages for positions currently established in the District, and;

WHEREAS, the Fire District has determined that the establishment of a wage structure would serve its best interests for employees;

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Middle, County of Cape May as follows:

1. The position of Fire Official (Full Time) shall be salaried at \$59,980.00 The position of Fire Inspector ( Full Time ) shall be salaried at \$47,120.75
2. The position of Fire Inspector (Part Time) shall be hourly. Fire Inspectors (Part Time) currently employed by the District shall receive \$28.00 per hour.
3. The positions of Commissioner shall be salaried at \$400.00 per month.
4. The position of Secretary and Treasurer of the Board of Fire Commissioners shall be salaried at \$500.00 per month.
5. The position of Vehicle Maintenance shall be salaried at \$600.00 per month
6. The position of Custodian shall be salaried at \$400.00 per month.

NOW THEREFORE, be it FURTHER RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1, Township of Middle, County of Cape May that the salaries and wages as described in this resolution shall be effective January 11, 2021.
